North Hertfordshire Local Development Framework Local Development Framework - Land Allocations Additional Suggested Sites Consultation July 2009

You may remember that in January 2008 we published the "Land Allocations Issues and Options Paper" for consultation. At that time we asked you for your views on 159 potential development sites which could help to meet needs and targets for housing, employment and other land uses. In response we received several thousand representations, these included suggestions for a further 125 sites which could be considered for development. We now need to find out what you think about these 125 suggested sites.

- We will not accept any representations on the original 159 Issues and Options sites (these sites are shown in grey on the maps) or any suggestions for new sites.
- We will only accept e-mail representations to ldfconsultations@north-herts.gov.uk and not to personal e-mail addresses.

Once the consultation period has finished we will look at all the comments made to the 284 sites and decide which ones we think would be the best to allocate for development. There will then be another opportunity for you to comment on the chosen sites as part of a Preferred Options consultation.
